As we walk into the sanctuary, everything is always in place and ready for worship. SLC's Worship & Music Ministry has many dedicated teams that help in the weekly preparations. The Altar Guild team is responsible for setting up for Holy Communion and Baptisms. The volunteers are divided into monthly teams

whose responsibilities include: filling the candles, changing the eternal candle, placing fresh linens on the altar, preparing the bread & wine and placing it on the altar, changing the seasonal paraments, and cleaning up which includes pouring the leftover wine into the ground & taking the remaining bread home to feed the birds. The 8:00 team serves on Saturday & early Sunday, while the 11:00 team cleans up following the second service. Some folks have been committed to this ministry for many years. Val Stueven has been purchasing the bread & wine for over 15 years. Mary Lou Dahl creates the flower arrangements & takes care of flower donations following worship.
