Our preschool offers both AM & PM Pre-Kindergarten classes on M/W/F; a 3 1/2 year old class on M/W/F; a 3 year old class on T/TH; and a 2 year old class on M/W. All classes have a limit of 10 children. Led by Director Nancy Williams, the staff have a combined 72 years of experience teaching at our school.
