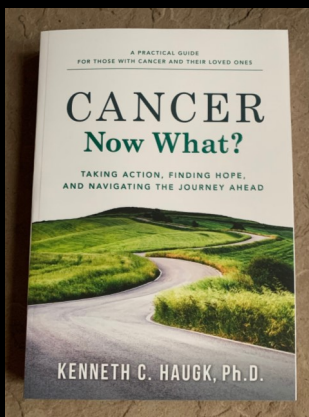
SLC Health Ministry Faith Community Nurse

Through the commitment of Lisa Ottenbacher, MSN, RN we began a Health Ministry in partnership with Faith Community Nursing. A retired U.S. Navy nurse, Lisa volunteers her time and expertise to provide SLC's Health Ministry. A Faith Community Nurse (FCN) is a registered nurse who combines both nursing and spiritual commitment in a healing ministry in a faith community. Lisa is a trained FCN who offers health focused visits to members in their homes, the hospital or long term care and rehabilitation facilities. Through our Health Ministry, Lisa provides individual health counseling, educational sessions, and at times end of life bedside care.
