SLC Prayer Ministry



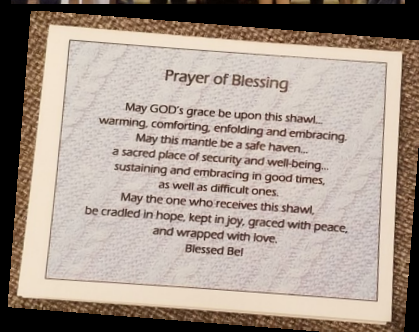
Always open as a place for quiet meditation and prayer

Silverdale Lutheran's Prayer Shawl Ministry began in 2004 under the guidance of Pastor Emily with 25 active prayer shawl ministers. The group would meet monthly to create and pray over the shawls. Since 2004, over 550 shawls have been shared for joy and comfort.

Who are the recipients of these handcrafted blessings? Each confirmand; expectant moms, our pastors and interns; those facing surgery; folks battling cancer; couples getting married; those in the hospital; anyone going through a difficult time; to celebrate friendships...the prayer shawl ministry answers each request.

During 2019, 40 prayer shawls were given out. Now currently 8 - 10 prayer shawl ministers create and pray over the shawls. This faithful team has been led by Darcy Lund and Karen Plank for the past ten years.
