Church Closure | "Stay at Home" Policy

From now and until April 8th the church will be closed to all visitors in an attempt to help "flatten the curve" regarding the spread of the virus (COVID-19). inFaith Community Foundation Scholarship


Applications are open now with a deadline submission of April 30, 2020.

The Silverdale Lutheran Church Scholarship was established to provide two educational scholarship awards annually to eligible candidates of SLC.

- One scholarship, in the amount of \$8,000, is available for a recipient attending a four-year college or university, and;
- One scholarship, in the amount of \$4,000, is available for a recipient attending a two-year community college or vocational/technical school.

Each scholarship will be paid in increments of \$2,000 each year to the institution the student attends.
