
The SLC app is now live and all it takes is to simply download from the App Store or Google Play, you will be searching for the "Silverdale Lutheran Church" app.

Treasurer Report


Below is a 3-year financial comparison of income vs. expenses through the end of October each year. The tables and graph below compare a 3-year financial picture considering offering income only. According to this picture, income through offerings for the month of October was \$68,464. This was greater than ministry, operations, and benevolence expenses of \$55,856, the lowest monthly expenses for 2020. Net income for October was \$12,990. Overall net income for 2020 remains positive at \$42,498 greater than expenses for the year. Current Assets equal \$483,927.
