We are working out details and will have a fully developed plan within the next week but need to start building our volunteer staff now. Plan on an event from 9-3 pm for each clinic with setup and cleanup time before and after. We will need the following volunteers: setup/cleanup, welcome center/registration, and "hosts" that will interact with the people waiting before and after their vaccination, to hand out water and gift bags and to help with social distancing. We will also need some help in preparing the gift bags in the days before.

MAN DATE Mandate will change slightly in that each night there will be a Bible study led by PB.




2021 GRADUATES – WE NEED YOUR PICTURE FOR OUR DISPLAY BOARD!



The above shows us falling short of our offerings target (\$-13,233)



Overall monthly operation and benevolence expenses for April 2021 were \$67,421. Expenses were \$11,860 less than April income of \$79,281. Overall net income for 2021 remains a positive \$17,852. Weekly offerings for April were greater than the estimated weekly needs to meet annual expenses. However, if we were operating at full capacity, we would be behind about \$400 per week in offerings for the year to meet estimated annual expenses.

Current assets equal \$440,679.
