Scout Sunday is the day each year we recognize the contributions of young people and adults to Scouting. The Scouting program at Silverdale Lutheran Church is more than just an activity for our youth to learn about the outdoors. Scouting provides fun, fellowship, and training to our youth as well as youth in our community. It emphasizes honesty, self-reliance, and respect. Through a year-round program, it affects character, citizenship, and personal fitness. The SLC Scout Units will be serving breakfast to the congregation as a thank you for the support the congregation gives to our scouts. Breakfast will be served between services. Donations will go to support scout equipment and help others get in to scouting.

We confess the truth of the Apostles' Creed each Sunday; we confess it as truth in our confirmations and for our babies at their baptisms. We confess our belief in our Triune God...but as Luther always asks, "What does this mean?" His large and small catechisms help us unpack the creeds, but what does each article of the creed mean to you personally?

We will look at our external influences — our childhoods, geography, gender, education, pivotal life events — how they have shaped our belief. Our universal creed is also our personal creed — so let's dig into it and unpack what each Person of the Trinity means to us personally and how that belief shapes who we are as individuals and as the Church.

This is an important time for women aged 18+ to set aside for self care; a time for tending to yourself so that you can tend to the others you serve in your busy and sometimes overwhelming lives.

The meals are always delicious, and we will have plenty of free time to walk in nature, nap, get a massage at Alderbrook, read, chat...whatever fills your cup. It starts Friday at dinner time until Sunday at lunch, and you can come as late as you need on Friday. You can even come for the day on Saturday if you like.

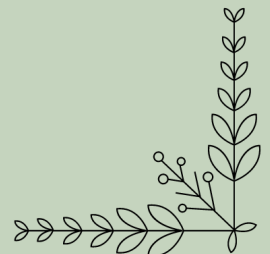

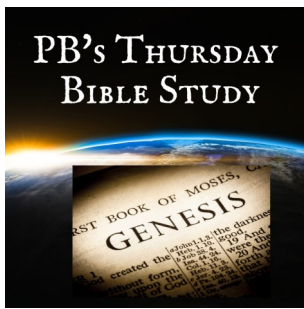

The Silverdale Lutheran Church member non-refundable registration fee is \$25.00 per child.

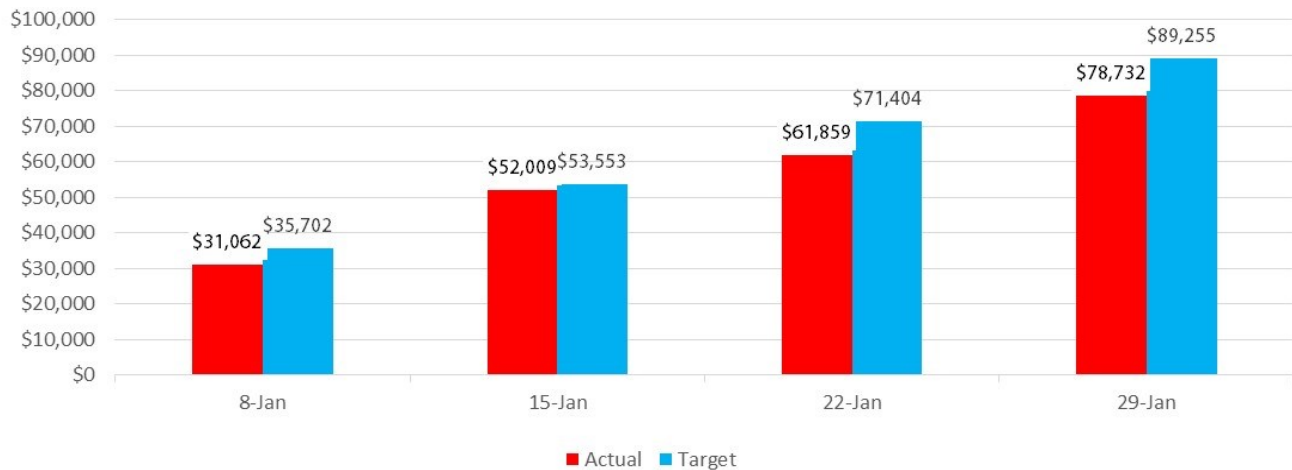
Regular non-refundable registration fee is \$75.00 Open registration begins on Monday, March 13th.

Actual vs Target

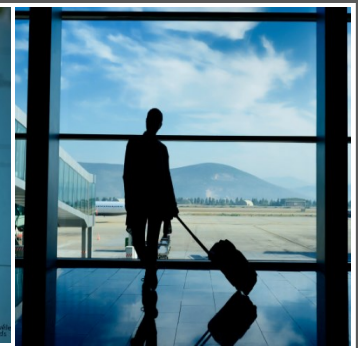
SLC CUMULATIVE OFFERING GIFTS

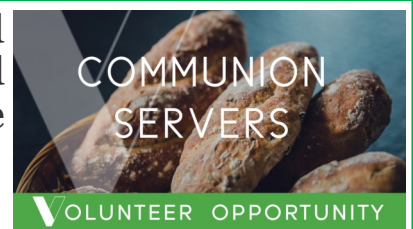
