We anticipate organ delivery the week of August 24 with installation completed that same week. Meta Organworks founder Daniel Lemieux, an award-winning organist in his own right, will then provide us with the first musical offering from the new organ. How exciting is that?



This organ has been paid for by estate gifts from various Silverdale Lutheran members. The families of those who provided this gift should feel good knowing their family member has created a lasting legacy for the whole church. Their gifts are timely as our current Rodgers organ is becoming obsolete with replacement parts no longer made.

An e-mail went out to you yesterday inviting donations toward the purchase of this organ. We would like to reiterate that SLC has estate gifts from former members that fully cover the cost of our new instrument. However, we also want to give the congregation the opportunity to take ownership and support this venture. This is why you received the invitation to support the organ yesterday. Gifts toward the organ allow us to use our estate gift funds for other needed improvements and projects.
