Juliana Cormier Juliana Cormier graduates from Enumclaw High School and will begin a Pharmacy Technician Internship program through Kaiser in the fall.




#### **Riley Gum**





Unfortunately, we had another poor giving month in May, leaving us now \$27,680 behind for the year. Our giving so far for the year is basically the same as last year and has not kept up with this year's increases due to inflation and giving staff the recommended COLA. The short fall has not been consistent each month. January, March, and April we covered our ministry expenses but for some reason offerings were low in February and May. Look for more information regarding our financial stewardship in the coming weeks. However, one thing that needs reiterated, please remember that our estate gifts from former members CANNOT be used for our budgeted expenses.
