UPCOMING CHANGES TO SLC CAMPUS SECURITY

Due to the FEMA Security Grant that SLC received, we are in the process of purchasing additional cameras, a new access control system for specific doors and a new alarm system. The cameras will aid in providing additional surveillance around the campus and the installation of a new access control system will allow us to lock down doors that have been equipped with 'Access Control' immediately in an emergency situation. Also, we are in the process of purchasing a new facility alarm system that will integrate with the cameras and the access control system.

Why does this concern you and how am I impacted?

With the installation of the new equipment, it will be necessary for Bruce to make contact with each person that currently has access to the church, possesses a key and has a PIN number for our current alarm system.

More to follow as this develops further, but anticipate more communication from the church regarding the installation of these new systems and ultimate follow-up with Bruce to ensure you have the appropriate credentials for continued access.
