


Deadline to register - Tuesday March 4th



We continue to give thanks to God for our amazing finish to 2024 as we overcame a significant deficit and finished in the black. However, we did fall short of expenses in January by \$9700.



There were too large expenses that contributed to the shortfall, the cleaning and repair of our bells (which hasn't been done in many years) and our first quarterly insurance bill. Remember that our budget passed for this year had only a very small increase, but COLAs were given to all staff so our payroll expenses have increased this year. Let's keep our ministry going strong in 2025!
