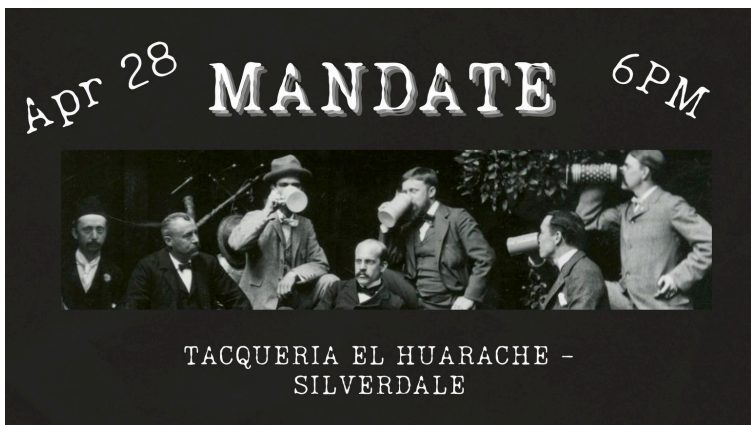

Possible New Christ Centered AA Group

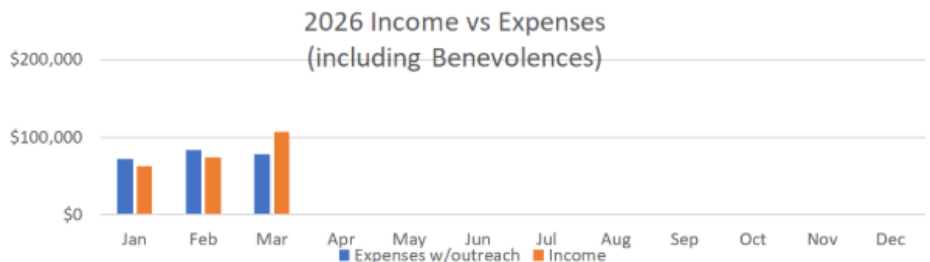

We are delighted to share that our ministry income exceeded \$100K in March and exceeded our March expenses by \$29,544. This made up the \$20K deficit we had in the first two months leaving us \$9,746



ahead after the first quarter. This is due to very generous giving, the advantage of having five Sundays in March, and our expenses being below what is typical. Being ahead after the first quarter is certainly an indication of the engagement members and friends of SLC have in our mission of “Connecting more to Christ” via Word and Sacrament and “loving Kitsap and the world” through our many service programs and events. Thank you! Let’s keep it going as we head into summer! We do have a number of large payments this month for Lutherhaven and our insurance.

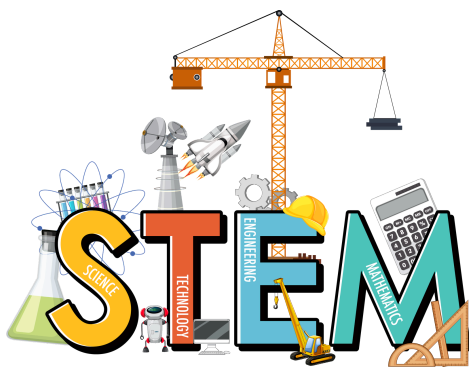
