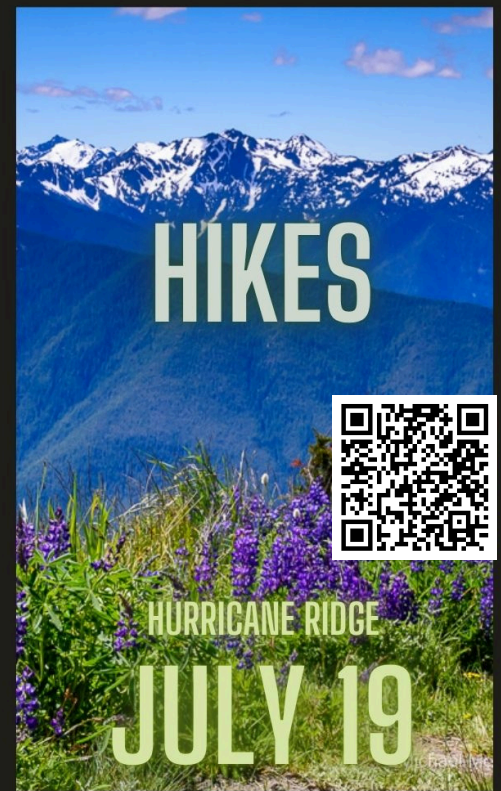
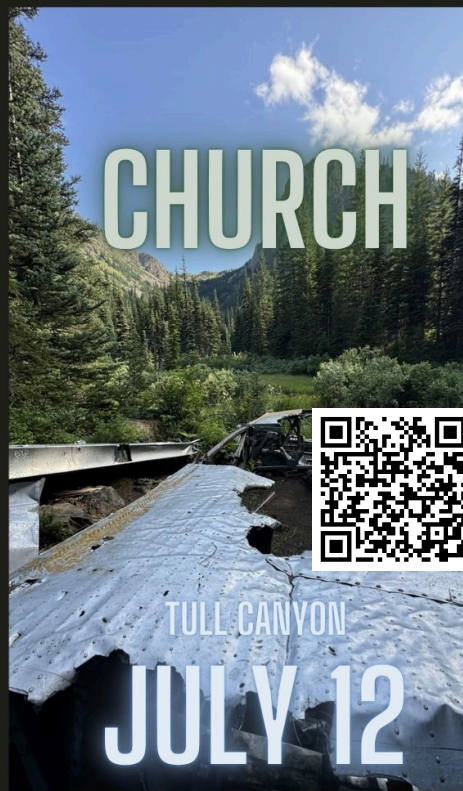

In 2025 803,181 kits and quilts were sent to 15 countries including those areas within the USA devastated by fires and flooding.

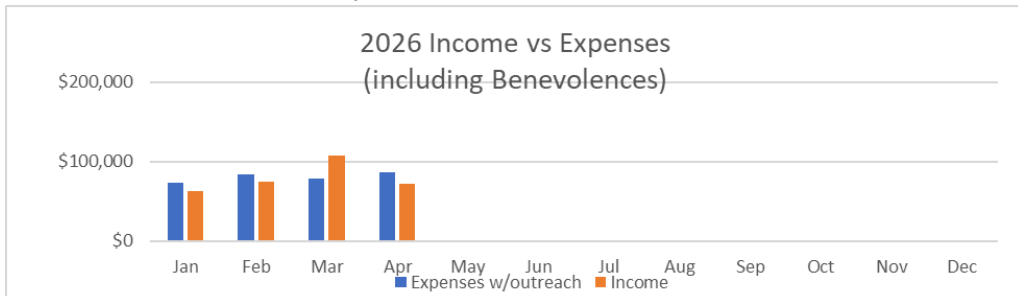
